GENERAL DESCRIPTION: The Relief Maintenance Worker, reporting to the Facilities Manager and working out of different locations, is responsible for cleaning and maintenance, ensuring safe and healthy operation of the building, and responding to emergencies as required and necessary. This position is part of CUPE LOCAL 7797.

MAJOR DUTIES:

- Overall maintenance and cleaning of the building, including mopping, sanitizing of toilets/urinals, sinks, showers, tabletops, sweeping, vacuuming of various rooms and offices, as well as snow removal.
- Periodic washing of walls.
- Moving supplies, assisting with receiving shipments.
- Ensure a secure building and a clean, safe and healthy work environment.
- Setting up tables, chairs and /or other equipment for meetings, special events, etc.
- Experience with and adherence to emergency and fire procedures.
- Repair and maintenance of equipment, furnishings, etc.
- Responsible for building lock-up and liaison with security & emergency services if needed.
- · Cleaning and maintenance.
- Maintaining sufficient inventory levels of supplies.
